

Welcome to Maximum Chances. Our purpose is to help children with Autism Spectrum Disorders gain access to educational services, therapies and cutting edge bio-medical treatments.

This application for is for potential funding of services for **WHITE BRIDLE**. If you have a child on the Autism Spectrum and would like to start or continue therapy services at **WHITE BRIDLE**, we would like the opportunity to help.

SELECTION CRITERIA FOR FUNDING

Your application will be considered based on our selection criteria for funding, which aims to provide funding to the neediest applicants. Funding will be allocated based on the following criteria:

- ***EXTENT TO WHICH CHILD MAY BENEFIT FROM SERVICES***
- ***HOUSEHOLD INCOME AND SIZE****
- ***INSURANCE COVERAGE RELATIVE TO TREATMENT NEEDS***
- ***NUMBER OF FAMILY MEMBERS WITH ASD/APSPERGER'S DIAGNOSIS***
- ***CURRENT FAMILY SITUATION INCLUDING HARDSHIPS AS A RESULT OF THE DIAGNOSIS***
- ***PARENTS ARE ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY***

Along with the application, you will be asked to submit the last 2 years tax returns for verification.

PROGRAMS AND POST-FUNDING APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

MAXimum Chances allows applicants to apply for a single program at White Bridle. White Bridle offers 10-week therapeutic riding programs for children ages 2-12 during the fall and spring, and an 8-week program during the summer. For each of these programs, the family will be required to pay a per session co-payment toward your child's fees. Maximum Chances will contribute \$50 per session (\$500 total for fall and spring programs; \$400 total for summer program). The family is responsible for a \$10 co-payment per session, payable at the time of the session to White Bridle (\$100 total for fall and spring programs; \$80 total for summer program).

Because of the significant investment by MAXimum Chances for the White Bridle program, it is important for students to be in attendance to benefit from the services. MAXimum Chances must pay White Bridle for the session, regardless of whether a child is in attendance or not. Therefore, funding may be withdrawn by MAXimum Chances after two UNEXCUSED absences. Absences will be excused for illness if a doctor's note is provided, for the observance of religious holy days, or for any cause deemed excused by the MAXimum Chances.

All funds from Maximum Chances will be paid directly to **WHITE BRIDLE**. Your monthly co-payment will be paid directly to **WHITE BRIDLE**. If an applicant receives funding from any other source (eg insurance or grant) for the White Bridle program, the applicant must disclose this to

Maximum Chances immediately. If the alternate funding exceeds the applicant's co-payment share, Maximum Chances may reduce payments by the amount that the alternate funding exceeds the co-payment. Co-payments must be made on at the time of service. If an applicant misses two co-payments, funding may be withdrawn by MAXimum Chances for the remainder of the sessions in the program.
